You are invited to the 27th annual Door County Classic & Wooden Boat Festival

The spotlight will be on classic boats at the Door County Maritime Museum when we host our 27th Annual Door County Classic & Wooden Boat Festival, August 11-13 in Sturgeon Bay. Sharing the spotlight with all the finely crafted vessels from sail and runabouts to kayaks and canoes are the colorfully decorated and hand-crafted Sikaflex vessels. The Sikaflex Challenge always draws an enthusiastic crowd during construction, time trials at sea and eventual destruction. Meanwhile, a variety of demonstrations are part of the festival. And it doesn't stop there. We have also partnered with the city's Maritime on Madison festival (immediately adjacent to our site) to provide music, children's activities, shopping specials, wine and beer tasting, and much more. Admission to the festival is free.

Show visitors can choose their favorite boats as they walk the docks. People's Choice Awards will be awarded in the following categories: Favorite Classic Inboard, Favorite Classic Outboard, Favorite Sailboat, Favorite Fiberglass Classic, Favorite Non-Powered Boat, Favorite Model Boat, Favorite Unique Craft and Overall Best of Show.

Just for you registered boaters is Friday's "Bay to Lake Lighthouse Cruise." Following a tour of the tug John Purves at the museum, boaters will jump aboard their boats and head past the largest shipyard on the Great Lakes to the Sherwood Point Lighthouse. Upon your return you will tie up at the Sturgeon Bay Yacht Club for lunch (from its menu). After eating, the cruise will continue through the historic ship canal to the U.S. Coast Guard Station lights. We'll reverse course out on the big lake and return to the museum to prepare for the evening cocktail reception.
