The Rebel

Eric & Kathy's 1958 Streblow Rebel 19' is one of the oldest surviving Streblow inboards. It was purchased as a derelict in 1994, and was refurbished and returned to regular use by the Moberg family over the next 3 years. Since that time continuous additional steps have been taken to return it to original condition, with some guidance from the Streblow Boat Co. Most of the side and bottom planking is original. It is one of only two 19' Streblows built in 1958, and has the original Cal Connell Cadillac 390 cu. in. engine. Only one other Streblow used this engine, which was the most powerful engine available in 1958. The Rebel is used regularly on the Fox Chain in Northern Illinois.
